# 8.32 DADRA AND NAGAR HAVELI



#### 8.32.1 Introduction

The Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli is situated on the western coast between lat 20°0' & 20°25' N and long 72°50' and 73°15' E. It has an area of 49,100 ha divided into two distinct geographical units: Dadra, and, Nagar Haveli by a part of Gujarat. It has hilly terrain towards the north-east and east, surrounded by Sahyadri range of Western Ghats. The terrain is intersected by the river Daman Ganga and its three tributaries.

The average annual rainfall ranges between 2,000 to 2,500 mm. The average annual temperature ranges between  $25^{\circ}$  C to  $27.5^{\circ}$  C.

The population of the Union Territory, is 220,490 (*Census 2001*) of which the rural population is 77.11% and urban 22.89%. The population density is 449 persons per km². Scheduled Tribes constitute 62.2%. The livestock population is 78,000 (*Livestock Census 2003*), which has increased by nearly 10% since the census of 1992. Land use pattern of the Union Territory is given in Table 8.32a

#### 8.32.2 Forest Resources

The recorded forest area is  $204 \, \mathrm{km}^2$ , which is  $41.55 \, \%$  of the geographic area of the UT. By legal status, Reserved Forests constitute  $97.55 \, \%$ , and Protected Forests,  $2.45 \, \%$ .

Major forest type occurring in the Union Territory is Tropical Moist Deciduous forest.

## 8.32.3 Protected Areas

An area of 9,216 ha is being managed as protected area under one Wildlife Sanctuary, which constitutes 18.77% of the geographical area.

## 8.32.4 Forest Cover




Fig. 8.32 : Forest Cover Map of Dadra & Nagar Haveli

The forest cover of the UT, based on satellite data of November 2004, is 221 km $^2$ , which is 45.01% of the geographic area. Moderately dense forest is 130 km $^2$  and open forest, 91 km $^2$ . The forest cover of UT is shown in Fig. 8.32.

There is no change in forest cover and its density as compared to the previous assessment (based on satellite data of November-December 2002) hence no change matrix is



given. Since Dadra and Nagar Haveli has only one district, the details given for the UT is also valid for the district.

# 8.32.5 Tree Cover

Tree cover of Dadra and Nagar Haveli has been estimated following a sampling based approach. A separate exercise

was carried out where high resolution satellite data (5.8m) has been used for identification of tree patches for field inventory. The estimated tree cover in the UT is  $28\,\mathrm{km}^2$ . The forest and tree cover of the UT is presented in the Table 8.32b.
