Forest Survey of India (FSI) is a national organization under the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India and is responsible for forest resource assessment of the country. FSI also takes up National level projects sponsored by the central and state government.

Applications are invited for engagement of 10 Technical Associates (JRF) For DIP related works under DSS and E-greenwatch Projects. The services of TA's will be required initially for a period of one year but their services are likely to be continued further.

Essential Qualification for Technical Associates (JRF)

1. Post Graduate in basic Science/Environmental Science/Allied subjects and NET qualified (NET-JRF) OR Graduate Degree in Professional Courses and GATE or equivalent qualifications.
2. Working knowledge of DIP/GIS.

Desirable Qualification for Technical Associates (JRF)

1. Post Graduate in Remote Sensing and GIS or having ten months' PG diploma course in RS/ GIS from a Recognized Institution
2. At least 6 months experience in DIP/ GIS related work in Forestry or other applied areas

Age:

The upper age limit for JRF is 28 years as on the last date of submission on online application. The upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates.

Emoluments:

TA (JRF): consolidated Rs 16,000/- per month and HRA (as per Govt Rule)

Touring

Technical Associates (JRF) may be required to go on tour for field work etc. for which they will be entitled to TA/ DA as admissible to Junior Technical Assistants of this organization.

Selection Criterion:

Candidates fulfilling the desired qualifications and experience will have to fill up the application form which can be downloaded from our website: www.fsi.nic.in. The duly filled up application form after signature has to be scanned and sent as e-mail attachment to FSI (e-mail: dgfsi@fsi.nic.in). **The scanned copy of the application form along with attested copy of experience certificate should reach to FSI through e-mail by 5.30 pm of 10th October, 2014** The short listed candidates will be intimated over phone and/or e-mail for a selection test which is tentatively scheduled in the **fourth week of October, 2014**. The short listed candidates will have to produce the original application form duly signed and photograph affixed on it on the day of selection test. The candidates have to produce all their original documents on the day of selection test. The selection test may comprise of a written test and/or hands on test and/or interview. Selection will be done on the basis of their qualification, experience and their performance in the written test and/or hands on test and/or interview. Decision of the Director General, FSI will be final. No TA/ DA will be paid for appearing in the test/ interview.

Interested candidates may apply as per the procedure given above. Application received after due date will not be considered.
