12722—VIF-156/46-R.—Whereas the Governor is satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest to apply to the private forest described in the Schedule hereto annexed the provisions of Chapter I of the Bihar Private Forests Act, 1946 (Bihar Act of 1946).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the said Act, the Governor is pleased to declare his intention of constituting the said forest a protected forest and to direct that any landlord's interests are likely to be affected by the said notification may within three months from the date of

this notification present to the Deputy Commissioner of Hazaribagh an application in writing stating his objections to the said forest being constituted a private protected forest.

2. The Governor is further pleased, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 21 of the said Act, to order that until the publication of a notification under section 29 of the said Act in the *Bihar Gazette*, all rights to cut, collect and remove any trees, or any class of trees, in or from the said forest shall, subject to the conditions and exceptions specified in the Second Schedule hereto annexed and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any contract, grant or record-of-rights, cease to exist.
