The Governor is further pleased, in exc. of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 21 of the said Act, to order that until the publication of a notification under section 29 of the said Act in the Bihar Gazette, all rights to cut, collect and remove any trees, or any class of trees, in or from the said forest shall, subject to the conditions and exceptions specified in the Second Schedule hereto annexed and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any contract grant or record-of-rights, cease to exist.
